CCYS Membership

POLICY - CCYS offers membership to all persons who have an interest in boating activities. These rules have been produced to ensure fairness and equality for all members. CCYS facilities are provided on a 'user-pays' basis to authorised persons, with discounts available for current members where decided by the Board. CCYS provides many social and educational events and encourages participation of its members and their guests.

- 1.0 Membership Application Procedure**
 - 1.0.1 Applicants must complete the appropriate form and provide all information requested therein. Omissions may delay approval.
 - 1.0.2 The application must include the names, membership number and signature of both the Proposer and Seconder. [Clause 12.7]
 - 1.0.3 The application together with the prescribed fees (see Schedule of Rates) must be lodged with CCYS Administration/Secretary
 - 1.0.4 Only the applicants name, type of membership, and boat name (if applicable) shall be posted on the CCYS Notice board for a period of not less than 14 days prior to the application being submitted to the Board for consideration.
 - 1.0.5 Any member may view the membership application upon request to the Secretary or Authorized Person
 - 1.0.6 **The Board shall consider the application at the next available Management Committee meeting. Should the Board reject the membership, the fee will be refunded in full and ID card and sticker to be returned to the office.**
- 1.1 Vetting of Applications for Membership**
 - 1.1.1 A member who wishes to exercise their right to oppose any membership application must submit to the Secretary a written statement of their objection before the application is submitted to the Board for consideration. Verbal objections will not be accepted.
- 1.2 Approval of Membership**
 - 1.2.1 Applicants approved for membership shall be advised in writing and, subject to payment of the prescribed fees (see Schedule of Rates) shall be issued with a membership number and card together with a copy of the current Rules, and their details shall be recorded in the Membership Register.
 - 1.2.2 Applicants who are not approved shall be advised in writing. [Rule 12.8]
- 1.3 Member Obligations**
 - 1.3.1 Applicants who are granted and accept membership of CCYS agree to be bound by the Rules, By-laws and Policies of CCYS
 - 1.3.2 Members shall not use their membership privileges for personal gain or advantage other than recreational/educational benefit.
 - 1.3.3 Members who do not comply with or disregard the Rules, By-laws or Policies shall be deemed in breach of agreement and will be addressed by the Board.
- 1.4 New Membership Activity**
 - 1.4.1 The privileges and obligations of CCYS membership become effective at the time of approval of such membership by the Board.
- 1.5 Currency of Membership and Renewals**
 - 1.5.1 The CCYS membership year is from the 1st July to the 30th June the following year
 - 1.5.2 All annual membership fees are due and payable the first day of the new membership year
 - 1.5.3 CCYS will issue renewal notices to all members one month prior to expiry date of the current membership year. A discount may be offered to members who pay their fees before 1st July. Such discounts will be shown on renewal notices.
 - 1.5.4 A 'grace period' of one month (up to 1st Aug) will be allowed for payment of membership fees, during which time membership privileges and entitlements shall remain.
 - 1.5.5 Memberships that remain unpaid after 1st August will be classed "Non-Financial" and not entitled to any privileges or discounts until payment is received. Members who remain unpaid for a period of 6 months (31st Dec) will have their membership cancelled, and will be required to re-apply for membership
- 1.6 Pro-rata Membership Fees**
 - 1.6.1 Memberships are for a full twelve month Financial Year only. Partial membership terms or pro-rata fees are not available except during the months of May and June (except By-law 1.7.4)
 - 1.6.2 Membership applications approved during the months of May and June may be charged pro-rata when paid with the following years membership.
- 1.7 Classes of Membership (see full list in the Constitution)**
 - 1.7.1 **Ordinary Member** shall be a person over the age of 18 years who shall be entitled to take part in the management of CCYS and to vote at meetings and who shall be entitled to all the privileges and subject to all the obligations of CCYS membership.
 - 1.7.2 **Family Member** shall be a single family unit consisting of 2 persons over the age of 18 years who shall be entitled to take part in the management of CCYS and to vote at meetings and who shall be entitled to all the privileges and subject to all the obligations. Family memberships shall include children up to 18 years of age but such children shall have no voting or management rights.
 - 1.7.3 **Associate Crew Member** shall be a person over the age of 18 years who shall be entitled some of the privileges as determined by the Board and subject to all the obligations of CCYS. Such associate member shall not be entitled to take part in the management of CCYS and cannot vote at meetings.
 - 1.7.4 **Absentee Membership** is only available after 12 months of full membership and subject to conditions and approval of the Board
 - 1.7.5 **Temporary Member** shall be a person over the age of 18 years. Period of membership is max of 3 months. The fee include Dinghy fee and valid to last day of month paid for. Member shall not be entitled to take part in the management of CCYS and cannot vote at meetings.
- 1.8 Boat Yard Discounts**
 - 1.8.1 Boat yard discounts are only available from three months after commencement of membership.

Boat Register - optional

- CCYS provides and maintains a data base which includes ownership details, insurance and vessel specifications of member vessels.
- Only CCYS registered vessels may display the letters "CCYS" on their vessel, or fly club burgee to signify club registration
- Only CCYS registered vessels are entitled to discounts offered by CCYS / RFS for use of hardstand, marina and vessel storage (Refer 1.8)
- CCYS vessel registration includes indemnity of CCYS and RFS for and during use of CCYS facilities
- CCYS vessel data base shall be made available to affiliated clubs where such vessel intends to visit, use or partake in that club's facilities
